1. Eugene Debs, an icon of the Labor movement in the late 19th and early 20th century, was held in this Woodstock building for six-months.
2. At 126 years old, this monumental Woodstock company has been a part of the community even longer than the Library.
3. Utilized in Orson Welles' very first movie, this large musical instrument now lives by the front door of one of Woodstock's many churches.
4. Containing nearly half-a-million gallons of water, this Woodstock recreation destination is very popular in the summer.
5. This park, with its distinctive bandstand, was featured prominently in the movie *Groundhog Day*.
