Unlawful Failure to Register as a Sex Offender

On Friday, September 25th, 2015, after conferring with the McHenry County States Attorney's Office, Woodstock Police Department detectives obtained an arrest warrant against 26 year old Jose J. Quintero for a violation of the Illinois Sex Offender Registration Act.

The arrest warrant was the result of an approximate one week long investigation of attempting to locate Quintero. The investigation revealed he was no longer residing at the address in the 100 block of W. Willow Ave. Woodstock, in which he was registered to be residing at. The result of the investigation determined that Quintero was residing in the Chicago area at a relative's residence for a period of time greater than three days.

On Saturday, September 26th, Quintero responded to the Woodstock Police Department where he was taken into custody for the warrant. Quintero was unable to post the required \$15,000 for bond and was transported to the McHenry County Adult Correctional Facility, whereas on Monday afternoon, he remains in custody. Quintero's next court date is scheduled for September 30th, 2015 at 9:00 am.

Individuals who are required to register as a sex offender under the Illinois Sex Offender Registration Act must, within three days, register and report changes with the Chief of Police in the municipality in which he or she resides or is temporarily domiciled for a period of time of three or more days.
