Dear Resident,

This letter is being distributed to the residents on Tappan Street as an update of the current construction status. Throughout this project, several unanticipated and unavoidable events have occurred, causing a delay in the planned schedule. These events have also caused an interruption in normal traffic patterns, occasionally requiring the roadway to be entirely closed during construction activities. Be advised that this roadway will continue to be re-opened by the end of each work-day.

The project is still progressing but additional work is required to resolve all the encountered conflicts. Assuming favorable weather for construction, the updated progress schedule will consist of the following activities:

- Continue excavation along the west edge curb line on Tappan Street, ending approximately 200 feet north of the intersection at Terry Court
- Continue installation of large-diameter storm sewer pipe and manholes in the excavated trench along the west edge of Tappan Street
- Filling excavated trenches and topping off with stone and asphalt grindings
- Restoring disturbed areas with topsoil, seed and blanket
- Opening roadway and resumption of normal traffic and parking conditions

The above work is expected to be completed by the end of June, 2016. The City appreciates your patience and understanding while this work that will benefit all residents in the immediate area, is being completed.
