### >> What should you NOT put in your curbside recycling?

Most of us have access to a waste hauler that will take the basics: paper, plastics #1–6, glass, cardboard and aluminum. However, many of us are confused about some other items such as:

1. **Styrofoam such as egg cartons, meat trays, etc.:** These are NOT recyclable in our curbside even though some of them have the recycling "triangle" on the bottom. Please don't landfill it as there are many collection locations. See page 13.
2. **Greasy pizza boxes:** Even though you can recycle cardboard, if there is grease and/or food stains on the boxes, it should go into the trash as it compromises the recycling machinery. Feel free to cut off the top of the box (if it is clean) and recycle that!
3. **Plastic shopping bags:** These are a big no-no as they get caught up in the sorting machines at the recycling centers and cause all sorts of problems. Save them and then next time you go grocery shopping, recycle them at the entrance to the store. Better yet, bring your own bags!

The following locations accept paint for recycling. Spray paint, stains, and other paint related products (i.e. thinners) will not be accepted unless otherwise noted. (See the Household Hazardous Waste Section for information on how to dispose of these products and oil-based paint.) Commercial or contractor use of the program is prohibited. Most charge a fee based on quantity, so be sure to call first.

- Residents: Up to 10 containers of paint (pints, quarts or gallons) and two five-gallon containers per household per month. \$2 per container for additional volume.
- Non-residents: \$2 per container

Reusable paint that is brought in for recycling will be sorted by type and color. The paint will be mixed, strained and combined into 5-gallon containers and made available at no charge.

## Alternative Options for Disposing of Latex Paint

Latex paint is a low toxic, water-based product. Once it is dried solid, simply knock out the solid clump into your regular garbage. The steel or plastic paint container with a small amount of dry residue can be recycled in your curbside collection.

You can accelerate the drying process by:

1. Adding cat litter or oil absorbent to the paint until it is dried solid
2. Leaving the paint can out in the sun (lid off) until it is dried solid

Consider donating unused paint to a neighbor, relative, community recycling event, or social service agency that might be able to use it. Be sure to transport paint in sealed, leak-proof containers.



# ELECTRONICS, TVS & COMPUTERS



The IL Electronic Products and Recycling Act of 2012 bans certain electronics from landfills and requires them to be recycled. These products can contain hazardous chemicals that require special handling, as well as valuable metals that can be recycled. Electronics must be taken to an Illinois EPA-registered collector, recycler, or refurbisher who can accept these electronic devices for recycling. Certain electronics include, but are not limited to, TVs, computers, monitors, printers, DVD players, and video game consoles. Residential electronics may be set aside and taken to a special community event or to an approved electronics recycling drop-off location. 

# HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE



Household hazardous waste (HHW) refers to a wide variety of fertilizers, pesticides, chemical cleaners, oil, paints, stains, auto fluids, and other toxic materials used by residents. Residents should bring their household hazardous waste to an Illinois EPA-approved HHW drop-off location. There are four permanent locations in northern Illinois that are open to Illinois residents at no additional cost. If you have residential household hazardous waste to transport, please consider the following safer transport guidelines:

- Keep HHW in their original containers. Do not mix any substances together.
- Transport the waste in a clean, dry plastic container or plastic lined cardboard box and place in the trunk of your vehicle.

### Need to Dispose of Sharps (i.e. needles, syringes and lancets)? Here are some options for safe, legal disposal:

- As a last resort, sharps can be placed in a rigid, puncture-resistant container (such as a coffee container or laundry bottle) with a tape secured lid for disposal in your regular trash pickup. Please clearly label the container: "Do Not Recycle-Used Sharps." Never place used sharps in your recycling container.
