

GARAGE SALE STANDARDS

1. The term "garage sale" shall mean the temporary public sale of five (5) or more items of personal property, for no more than four (4) days at a time and no more than two (2) nonconsecutive times in a single calendar year, which is conducted on a premises zoned and used for residential activity and occupied by a residential dwelling, and which is conducted by the resident or residents residing on said premises. The term "garage sale" shall include yard sale, moving sale, and rummage sale, but shall not include temporary public sales conducted by a school, church, or similar institutional use. (Ord. 08-0-70, 11-18-2008, eff. 1-1-2009)
2. Garage sales are permitted in all residential zoning districts between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. and eight o'clock (8:00) P.M.
3. Signage advertising a garage sale shall be limited to one on premises sign and a maximum of two (2) off premises signs, each of which shall not be larger than two and one-half (2 1/2) square feet in area or have a height of more than three feet (3') above grade. Such signage shall be affixed with a sticker supplied by the city indicating that the required garage sale permit has been issued. The content of such a sign shall be limited to the time, date(s), and location of the garage sale. In addition, such signage shall be self-supporting and not attached to any utility pole, light pole, or street sign, and shall be removed within twenty four (24) hours of when the garage sale ends. Attention getting devices, including balloons, streamers, special lighting, noise making devices and similar displays, shall not be used to call attention to the garage sale.
